You do not have an assignment that goes with the reading. Closer to August there will be a study guide posted on reading. The second week of school there will be a test on the chapters.

I would recommend taking notes, highlighting, or completing the Module Assessments (the last 2-3 pages of the Chapter). If you complete the questions, they will not be collected for points, but something you could do to prepare for the test.

We decided to post the summer reading modules as pdfs on a OneDrive folder because the textbook is online and can be tricky to access for the first time. When you purchase the textbook, you will be given a redemption code. Teachers will show you how to use the access code on the HMH website, the first week of school. Your teachers didn't want potential frustration due to not being able to access the modules, to get in the way of you getting the summer reading done.

Please begin to chip away at the reading. Your teachers will message your class when the study guide is accessible, it will also be posted in the OneDrive folder and Schoology.
