99% of CB graduates typically enroll in college. Recent graduates were offered admission to Georgetown, MIT, Notre Dame, Stanford, Cal, all three military academies, all eight Ivy League schools, and many more throughout the country and abroad. Members of the Class of 2023 are attending colleges in 25 states, Washington D.C., and England.

CB leads the region in providing need-based tuition assistance. This year, the school is providing \$3.3 million to 483 young men and women.

CB offers 34 Honors and Advanced Placement courses.

CB's Media, Visual & Performing Arts Program offers courses in:

- Instrumental Music
- Media Arts (Video Production & Journalism)
- Theatre Arts
- Visual Arts
- Vocal Music

Four-year programs allow for advanced study in visual arts, instrumental music, and vocal music.

In a recent survey of CB graduates, 100 percent of respondents indicated that CB's academic programs prepared them for the rigors of college.

More than 70 student clubs and activities help students become involved in campus life outside of the classroom. Each day, CB students live the school motto of "Enter to Learn, Leave to Serve" through the Christian Service Program and student-led service clubs. **CB** athletes participate in 27 varsity sports. Professional athletic trainers work personally with student-athletes and coaches to develop and implement sport-specific training programs.

CB provides students with a four-year comprehensive counseling program, dedicated grade-level counselors, two fulltime college counselors, and a wellness program to proactively address the many challenges facing teens today.

Engineering Program

CB offers several UC-approved engineering courses for high school students including Fundamentals of Design, Principles of Engineering, Environmental Sustainability, Civil Engineering & Architecture, and two AP Computer Science courses.
